

**Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ) about the Deerfield Beach Computer Club (DBCC)**

- 1. Classes meet every Friday except holidays from 10:00-11:30 AM in the Le Club Activity Center, Room B, in Century Village East (CVE). We will not meet whenever our classroom is unavailable due to severe weather conditions, etc.**
- 2. Non-residents must enter through the West Gate at Powerline Road and West Drive and have their names on the weekly approved list. Have ID ready to show Guard.**
- 3. Doors open to the public at 9:30. Please be in the classroom no later than 10:00.**
- 4. Members in good standing will be admitted free to every class.**
- 5. Guests may attend one free class. To attend another, they must join the Club.**
- 6. We care about your privacy. All personally identifiable information (PII) you provide to the Club will be shared with Board members only.**
- 7. The parking area and the building restrooms are handicapped-friendly.**
- 8. Attendees must provide their own transportation to and from the classroom.**
- 9. We will not provide refreshments. Please bring your own and keep your area clean.**
- 10. The building has free unsecured Wi-Fi.**
- 11. Anyone under 18 years of age will not be permitted to enter the classroom.**
- 12. Certified and duly licensed therapy and service animals are permitted.**
- 13. Members are eligible to attend after class (11:30 AM-12:30 PM) Workshops on a variety of topics. They must register between 9:30 and 10:00 on the date of the Workshop and pay a \$1.00 entry fee at a designated table.**
- 14. New Individual and Renewal memberships are \$25. New Family and Renewal memberships are \$35. Memberships expire one calendar year from the date a member joins or renews.**
- 15. Pete Zambito will email membership dues renewal reminders to all members several weeks in advance. Dues must be paid by the last Friday in the renewal month to avoid placing the account in delinquent status. Members not in good standing will be ineligible to attend Workshops, attend special events, and may be denied entry to the classroom until their dues are paid. No partial dues payments will be accepted.**
- 16. Please make checks payable to the Deerfield Beach Computer Club. We do not accept credit cards. If you are paying in cash, please try to have the exact amount.**
- 17. Members are responsible for the conduct of their guests, aides, and pets.**
- 18. We reserve the right to deny entry to any member who uses profane language in class or continually behaves in a disruptive or disrespectful manner. In that case, the Board may suspend or revoke the membership with no partial or total refund given.**
